Thanks for getting back to me, I understand about the tennis courts - no problem.

Would it be possible, if the Rec is not being used on a Monday afternoon anyway to arrange a 'pay per head' fee that I pay to you depending on my numbers? This way, it ensures I have enough participants at each session to cover the costs but it would also mean as the classes grow in popularity that I could be paying you more than the £19+VAT. I have this arrangement in place with the facility I use in Wotton and they are paid £1 per head for each participant. Would this be something we could at least trial through April so I can check the demand of the session before committing additional payments?
