

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Stroud District Council

Referendum on the Neighbourhood Plan for Dursley Neighbourhood Area

1. A neighbourhood planning referendum will be held on **Thursday 15 November 2018**, to decide on the question below:

Do you want Stroud District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Dursley to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

2. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Stroud District Council by 12 midnight on **Tuesday 30 October 2018**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
3. New applications for postal votes or written instructions to change or cancel an existing postal or proxy voting arrangement must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Stroud District Council by **5pm on Wednesday 31 October 2018**.
4. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Stroud District Council by **5pm on Wednesday 7 November 2018**.
5. Applications to vote by 'emergency' proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer Stroud District Council by 5pm on Thursday 15 November 2018. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 7 November 2018. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 7 November 2018.
