Application for a Memorial Plaque

Dursley Town Council can arrange the supply of a bronze memorial plaque with "Trajan" type lettering. The bronze is fully powder coated and lacquered to prevent discolouration and has a cast bronze stem welded on the reverse of the plaque.

To apply for a memorial plaque for the "Garden of Remembrance" at Kingshill Cemetery or the "Garden of Rest" at St Mark's Burial Ground, please complete this application form and deliver to the Clerk of Dursley Town Council.

Before completing this form please ensure you have read and understand the Cemetery Regulations and current fees.

The applicant will receive an invoice for the cost of the plaque and confirmation of the wording. Upon receipt of payment the plaque will be ordered. Please note that delivery takes approximately 3/4 weeks from receipt of payment.

Kingshill Cemetery: the plaque may be collected from the Council Office for you to place in position in the Garden of Remembrance, or we can do this for you.

St Mark's Burial Ground: you will be notified when the plaque arrives and we will arrange for the plaque to be placed in the Garden of Rest

Planting in the Garden of Remembrance and the Garden of Rest: Written authorisation from the Council must be obtained before planting in the Garden of Remembrance/Garden of Rest. The Council would normally approve the planting of a hybrid tea rose bush or miniature rose bush, subject to the availability of space.
