MINUTES of the PROCEEDINGS of the MEETING of the TWINBERROW FOUNDATION held in the Methodist Church Rooms, Castle Street, Dursley, which commenced at 8.50 pm on Tuesday the 7th day of January 2014.

1. Apologies for absence

2. Minutes of the Twinberrow Foundation Meeting held on 1st October, 2013

The Minutes of the Twinberrow Foundation Meeting held on 1st October 2013, having been circulated among the members were taken as read, confirmed and signed by the Chairman as a correct record of the proceedings at that Meeting.

3. Declarations of Interest

No declarations of interest were received.

4. Update on the Sculpture & Play Trail

An update on the Trail had been received from the Vale Vision Working Group, and circulated to members with their agendas. Thanks would be relayed to the Vale Vision Sculpture Trail Working Party for their hard work in maintaining the Sculpture & Play Trail as a community feature in the wood for both residents and visitors.

It was agreed that trustees would undertake their next litter pick of the woods on a Saturday morning in the middle of March. The cost of providing a dog waste bin for the area would be investigated and the matter would be discussed at the next meeting in April.

5. Bottle-digging operation

Further to the October 2013 meeting, an update on the bottle-digging operation and subsequent restoration of the area of the wood had been circulated to members. Trustees noted that restoration and any replanting of the area would be in accordance with the Woodland Manager's instructions.

6. It was noted that:

- (i) The Dursley Dozen athletics event will be held on 9th February, 2014. Details of the route had been circulated to members and it was noted that a copy of the risk assessment and insurance had already been received.
- (ii) The Foundation has been awarded a grant of £3,000 by Dursley Town Council for woodland maintenance which would be received in April 2014.
