- (ii) Investigations by the Woodland Manager into possible work requirements following an incident in Twinberrow Woods on 12th January 2015, which involved the Ambulance Service breaking down a wooden post/barrier located on the track that runs from Twinberrow Lane and an exposed limestone path, following a slipping incident.

8. Any other urgent business
