## Lifting Covid Restrictions

Many restrictions have been lifted but Covid- 19 cases unfortunately remain high in certain areas across the country.

Everybody needs to continue to act carefully and remain cautious.

From 19<sup>th</sup> July the restrictions changed to the following:

**No limit on meeting people but try to meet others outside where possible.**

**People currently working from home should return to the workplace gradually.**

**Face coverings are recommended in crowded public spaces, such as public transport.**

**Social distancing is no longer mandatory.**

**Nightclubs can open and there is a return to full capacity for theatres and cinemas.**

**Businesses and large events are encouraged to use the 'NHS Covid pass' to limit the spread of the virus.**

Businesses still have a duty to manage the risk of covid to their employees and customers, so you may still see measures in place when you are out and about on the high street and using local businesses (e.g. wearing masks, sanitising, distancing). Please continue to support them.
