TOWN IMPROVEMENTS AND AMENITIES COMMITTEE

TERMS OF REFERENCE

AGREED AT COUNCIL ON 7th NOVEMBER 2017

1. The Town Improvements and Amenities Committee is a standing committee of the Town Council.
2. Its functions are:
 - (a) To ensure that the Council's public seats, litter bins, notice boards (other than those in areas controlled by other committees) and other street furniture are maintained and replaced as necessary.
 - (b) To ensure that the Council's bus shelters are cleaned and maintained; to ensure that the glass in the shelters in the Bus Station is cleaned.
 - (c) To ensure that the litter situation throughout the town is checked and to make arrangements with the District Council, as necessary, for collection and disposal of rubbish.
 - (d) To ensure that the War Memorial gates, pillars and forecourt are maintained.
 - (e) To ensure that the amenity areas at The Broadwell, and near the Town Hall are maintained and improved.
 - (f) To ensure that
 - (i) the trees along Kingshill Road, and
 - (ii) other small areas of shrubs/trees including the bank at Bull Pitch; bed near the Bus Station; trees near the bottom of White Way Hill; trees near the Youth Centre; trees near the rear of the Pet Shop are maintained.
 - (g) To deal with all public transport matters.
 - (h) To maintain and improve amenities within the town.
3. To prepare and submit to the Council an annual estimate of revenue expenditure in respect of town improvements and amenities.
