This is an elevated part of the site, with good views outwards towards Uley in the East and the wooded surroundings of Dursley to the West and South. Housing built on this part of the site would be visible from vehicles and pedestrians on the Uley Road, from Uley Bury and from woodland walks in Hermitage Wood and Dursley Wood. Rooves of houses built on the site of the old Mawdsleys works may be seen below the level of the ground at this location. Beyond the wooded area to the West lies a play area; the wooded area is understood to be part of the proposed development land.

The slopes of Stinchcombe Hill are prominent to the Northwest.
